FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By the first order in this application, Decision No. 36884 issued February 15, 1944, Applicant was authorized to utilize its gas facilities and to perform the necessary service and work in accordance with the terms of the contracts dated June 2 and June 15, 1943 with The Dow Chemical Company and Shell Chemical Company.

In this first supplemental application Applicant requests authority to enter into an agreement dated March 1, 1945 with Shell Chemical division of Shell Union Oil Corporation (formerly Shell Chemical Company) to supply natural gas to additional facilities in the synthetic rubber plant on the same basis as that on which service is rendered under the terms of the June 15, 1943 agreement.

A public hearing under the circumstances being deemed unnecessary, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company is hereby authorized to execute that amendatory agreement dated March 1, 1945 with Shell Chemical division of Shell Union Oil Corporation as set forth in the attachment in the first supplemental application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective as of the date  
hereof.
