OPINION AND ORDER

Harold Frasher and Hattie Harm, copartners doing business as Terminal Warehouse Company, own and operate a public utility warehouse in Fresno located on property leased from Southern Pacific Company. By verified application, authority is sought to sell the warehouse and equipment to Zellerbach Paper Company for a cash consideration of \$30,000. Operations will be continued at a new location in Fresno. Expense of transferring goods in storage will be borne by Terminal Warehouse.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Harold Frasher and Hattie Harm, copartners doing business as Terminal Warehouse Company, be and they are hereby authorized to sell the public utility property involved in this application to Zellerbach Paper Company, a corporation, in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached thereto.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
