FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

Ben Tunstall, doing business as Huntington Beach Victory Bus, has heretofore been granted a certificate for the transportation of defense workers between Newport Beach, on the one hand, and Douglas Aircraft Company, Long Beach, and California Shipbuilding Corporation Terminal Island, on the other hand, with certain restrictions. (1)

The service was authorized upon a showing by applicant that there existed a need for public transportation facilities to accommodate government workers in traveling between their homes and places of employment at defense plants.

Applicant now desires to be relieved of the responsibility of further providing such transportation service on the ground that it is no longer required. His application states that

"... all call and need for this service has ceased, both at Douglas and Calship (California Shipbuilding Corporation), and said riders have since been dismissed from the above named plants, and, therefore, there is no further need for this bus line or lines."

The Commission is advised by service managers at both Douglas Aircraft Company and California Shipbuilding Corporation that there

exists no further need for the service due to inactivity at the respective camps. In view of that situation, there appears no reason why authority for abandonment should not issue and the certificate be revoked. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not required.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Ben Tinstall by Decision No. 36943 is hereby revoked and annulled, and all tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission, and in effect, are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
