ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company by the above entitled application requests an order revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted it by Decision No. 33305 which authorized it to serve the Jolon Training Area.

The certificate in question was granted applicant to enable it to render highway common carrier transportation service to the Jolon Training Area used by the United States Army for certain military purposes during the war. The Army has now ceased to occupy the area and common carrier transportation service is no longer needed to or from it.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience or necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 33305, in Application No. 23878, is hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables filed with the Commission in compliance with said decision are hereby cancelled.
