SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In the above entitled proceedings Fortier Transportation Company, a copartnership, has been authorized to perform certain transportation at rates less than the established minimum rates. By verified supplemental application it is alleged that Fortier Transportation Company, a corporation, is succeeding to the business of the copartnership. It is requested that the outstanding authorizations be transferred to the corporation.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted Fortier Transportation Company, a copartnership, by Decision No. 32816, as amended, in Application No. 22548 and Decision No. 37338, as amended, in Application No. 26241, may be exercised by Fortier Transportation Company, a corporation.
