BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industry spur track at grade across Virginia Street and Fourth Street in the City of Berkeley, County of Alameda, at the locations described in the application. Said crossings shall be identified as follows:

Virginia Street as a portion of Crossing No. A-9-6,
Fourth Street as Crossing No. A-9-72-C.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 Crossing Signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at each crossing.

No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossings unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the streets protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as flagman.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-

tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require..

This order shall be effective immediately..
