ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across "W" Street in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-137.6. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection of Crossing No. 4-137.6 shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light crossing signals installed at the locations shown on the map attached to the application in lieu of the No. 4 wigwag in the center of "W" Street. No train, motor, engine or car shall be operated over the above mentioned spur across "W" Street unless said train, motor, engine or car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the street protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as flagman.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or
safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
