BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Jackson Street, in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-6.9.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded and paved, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs.

Applicant shall remove the two spur tracks shown in red on the map attached to the application, in so far as they lie in Jackson Street; and shall repair the roadway to conform to the remainder thereof:

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
