ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Pursuant to Decision No. 38363, issued October 30, 1945, John O. Cannon was granted a license to act as a motor carrier transportation agent upon the condition that he file, within sixty days, a bond satisfactory to the Commission. The sixty day period has expired, but a bond was not filed.

In the meantime, on November 30, 1945, Cannon applied for a renewal of his license but not having complied with the bond requirement there is no valid license subject to renewal and the Commission is compelled to dismiss said application. In order to acquire a license as such motor carrier transportation agent, it will be necessary for Cannon to file a new application as provided for in the Motor Carrier Transportation Agent Act.

In view of the foregoing facts, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be, and it hereby is dismissed.
