ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 34525, in Application No. 24266, authorized Market Hauling Company, a corporation, to acquire from Salvatore Lucchesi a highway common carrier right, in general, between Gilroy and San Jose and Oakland and San Francisco created by Decision No. 26470, in Application No. 18891. Leo Goscila, president of applicant corporation, informed the Commission by letters dated September 25, 1945, and December 28, 1945, that the carrier has abandoned all operations as a highway common carrier and requested the Commission to revoke the operative right therefor.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the highway common carrier operative right created by the decisions hereinabove referred to is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Market Hauling Company are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
