ORDER OF REVOCATION

Harry C. Hicks, doing business as Beacon Cabs, by the above entitled application requests permission to discontinue passenger stage service between Camp Haan, Perris, Hemet and Elsinore.

Applicant was authorized by Decision No. 34644, in Application No. 24372, to operate an automotive passenger stage service between the points above mentioned to provide transportation for military personnel stationed at Camp Haan. The Commission has been advised by the Commanding Officer of said camp that such service is no longer needed.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted Harry C. Hicks by Decision No. 34644, in Application No. 24372, is revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables filed with the Commission in the name of Harry C.
