FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER.

By Decision No. 35585, Pacific Motor Trucking Company was granted a certificate authorizing it to transport property as a highway common carrier between Camp San Luis Obispo and Morro Bay Small Craft Naval Base at Morro Bay. This Naval Base is situated approximately 10 miles westerly of Camp San Luis Obispo.

By its supplemental application, applicant requests the Commission to revoke the certificate above referred to. The supplemental application states that, pursuant to the certificate granted, applicant conducted highway common carrier operations between the points specified when so required; that no truck service has been operated by applicant between Camp San Luis Obispo and the Naval Base for some time past and it has been informed that the United States Navy suspended all operations at Morro Bay as of November 1, 1945, and that the Morro Bay Small Craft Naval Base will not be maintained as a permanent facility and therefore will not have need for applicant's service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED, that the certificate of public convenience

and necessity heretofore granted Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 35585 is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall within 60 days from the date hereof and on not less than one days' notice to the Commission and the public, issue appropriate supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
