BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to construct an industrial side track at grade across Douty Street in the City of Hanford, County of Kings, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B.D.E.-232.5. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded and paved, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 3 wigwag.

Applicant shall remove the track shown in yellow on the map (San Joaquin Division Drawing A-330) attached to the application, in so far as it lies in Douty Street, and shall repair the roadway to conform to the remainder thereof.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety
so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
