Southern California Freight Lines, a corporation engaged in the transportation of property as a highway common carrier, having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to execute a conditional sale contract providing for the purchase of eight automatic converter gears for the sum of \$9,118.43, of which \$1,803.43 will be paid in cash and the balance of \$7,315.00 will be payable in 23 equal monthly installments of \$205 and one installment of \$2,600, the first installment to be payable on February 10, 1946, with interest on deferred balances at the rate of 5%, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary; that the application should be granted, as herein provided; that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein; which purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, therefore,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

l. Southern California Freight Lines may, after the effective date hereof and on or before February 22, 1946,

execute a conditional sale contract in, or substantially in, the same form as that filed in this proceeding, providing for the payment of \$9,118.43 in the amounts and at the times set forth herein, for the purpose of financing the cost of said eight automatic converter gears.

- 2. The authority herein granted will become effective when applicant has paid the minimum fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which minimum fee is Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.
- 3. Within ten (10) days after the execution of the conditional sale contract under the authority herein granted, applicant shall file with the Commission a copy thereof as actually executed.
