ORDER

Southern California Freight Lines, a corporation en-
gaged in the transportation of property as a highway common
carrier, having applied to the Railroad Commission for per-
mission to execute a conditional sale contract providing for
the purchase of eight automatic converter gears for the sum of
\$9,118.43, of which \$1,803.43 will be paid in cash and the bal-
ance of \$7,315.00 will be payable in 23 equal monthly installments
of \$205 and one installment of \$2,600, the first installment to
be payable on February 10, 1946, with interest on deferred bal-
ances at the rate of 5%, and the Commission being of the opinion
that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary;
that the application should be granted, as herein provided; that
the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for is
reasonably required for the purpose specified herein; which pur-
pose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to
operating expenses or to income, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Southern California Freight Lines may, after the effective date hereof and on or before February 28, 1946,

execute a conditional sale contract in, or substantially in, the same form as that filed in this proceeding, providing for the payment of \$9,118.43 in the amounts and at the times set forth herein, for the purpose of financing the cost of said eight automatic converter gears.

2. The authority herein granted will become effective when applicant has paid the minimum fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which minimum fee is Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.

3. Within ten (10) days after the execution of the conditional sale contract under the authority herein granted, applicant shall file with the Commission a copy thereof as actually executed.
