ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company, by the above entitled application, requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted it by Decision No. 35802, in Application No. 25248, which authorized it to render highway common carrier service between Paso Robles and Estrella Airport located near Paso Robles.

During the war Estrella Airport was used by the United States Army. Military activity has ceased thereat and the Airport has been abandoned. No need for transportation service exists now.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 35802, in Application No. 25248, is hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time tables filed with the Commission in compliance with said decision are hereby cancelled.
