

ORIGINALDecision No. 38645

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of Industry spur across Wible Road, in the Town of Wible, Orchard, County of Kern, State of California. Application No. 27202

BY THE COMMISSION:

O.R.D.E.R.

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industry spur track at grade across Wible Road in the Town of Wible, Orchard, County of Kern, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BT-319.8-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
