ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pursuant to Decision No. 38365, dated October 30, 1945, the Commission issued a license as a motor carrier transportation agent to Isadore Berman. Said license was issued subject to the condition that the licensee provide a good and sufficient surety bond within 60 days from the effective date of the order. The time for filing such bond expired December 29, 1945, but no bond was filed within the time prescribed.

On December 10, 1945, the Commission, under the provisions prescribed therefor, and upon application, issued its renewal of the license originally granted in Decision No. 38365 for the year 1946⁽¹⁾. On January 10, 1946, a surety bond was filed covering applicant, but was rejected on two grounds: (1) that it was not filed within the 60 day period, and (2) that it was not in the form prescribed by the Commission. This information was communicated to the applicant.

Under the circumstances, the renewal of applicant's license⁽²⁾ is of no effect. The applicant has not complied with the bond requirements and hence there is no valid license subject to renewal.

In view of the foregoing facts, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 38480, on First Supplemental Application No. 26930, be, and it hereby is, revoked and annulled.
