ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 34937, in Application No. 24699, certificated Loren W. Smith to establish a passenger stage service between Pomona and the Los Angeles County Fair Grounds. Thereafter Decision No. 35166 authorized him to temporarily suspend such operation until March 1, 1943. By letter dated January 14, 1946, Smith informed the Commission that such service was not reestablished at the termination of the suspension period, that he has abandoned the operation and requests the Commission to revoke the certificate granted by said Decision No. 34937.

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED, that the passenger stage operating right created by Decision No. 34937 is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Loren W. Smith, applicable to service between Pomona and the Los Angeles County Fair Grounds, are hereby cancelled.
