BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Bay Avenue in National City, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-272.95-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 4%. Frotection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

The authorization herein contained shall be temporary in nature. The track shall be removed and the condition of the road surface reasonably restered to its original condition at the sole expense of applicant within a period of one year from the date of this order, unless further extended by authority of this Commission.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
