ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 36626, as amended by Decision No. 36798, Ted Morton and William V. O'Connor, partners, were authorized to conduct a passenger stage operation between Blythe and Morton Air Academy. By letter dated January 24, 1946, Ted Morton informed the Commission in part that:

"This service was discontinued approximately August 5, 1944 due to the termination, for the convenience of the Government, of the contract of Morton Air Academy with the United States for the training of Military Aviation Cadets. All operations ceased at approximately that date and it is not contemplated that any further operations will be conducted by Morton Air Academy in connection with this certificate above mentioned. We believe therefore that it is in order that such certificate be withdrawn at the earliest possible moment."

Therefore, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 36626, as amended by Decision No. 36798 is hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Ted Morton and William V. O'Connor are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
