OPINION AND ORDER

Southern California Edison Company Ltd. in this application requests the Railroad Commission to make an order authorizing the utility to carry out the terms of a special contract with the City of Azusa, which contract contains the terms and conditions under which the utility will supply electric service to the City. A copy of the contract dated December 10, 1945, is attached to and made a part of the application as Exhibit "A."

Applicant asserts that electric service has heretofore been rendered to the City in accordance with a contract dated October 1, 1941, which contract is terminated and superseded by the terms and conditions of the contract submitted herewith.

In support of its petition Applicant represents that the load characteristics of the City of Azusa have changed materially since the 1st day of October 1941, in that the demand for and use of energy has increased and that the load factor has improved, and that the proposed rates are designed to more adequately compensate for such improvement. The 1945 contract, like the 1941 contract, specifies a term of ten years from the date thereof and provides for continuance from month to month thereafter until terminated by either party on

prior written notice. The changes in the rate provisions of the contract are readily shown in the following tabulation:

It will be noted from the above table that more favorable rates apply where the demands exceed 3,000 kw per month and where the load factor equals or exceeds 55%.

The contract further establishes a minimum charge equal to the demand charge; a 30-minute maximum demand interval; a minimum monthly maximum demand of 70% of the maximum of the preceding eleven months. Demands occurring between ll_p.m. and 6_a.m. of the following day are to be ignored in establishing the billing demand. A power factor adjustment clause provides for a maximum penalty or discount of 10%. Service will be rendered at any standard nominal voltage of 2400 volts or more.

The contract further provides that the City will purchase all of its electrical requirements from the company for the initial 10-year period of the contract. In addition, it carries forward the provisions of the 1941 contract contract, the territory within which the respective parties will confine their operations, and outlines orderly procedures for acquisition by the City of Edison's distribution facilities in the event the incorporated limits of the City are expanded.

The Commission being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a hearing in the matter is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company Ltd. be and it is hereby authorized to carry out the provisions, to render the service, and to charge and collect the rates specified in that fertain agreement dated December 10, 1945, between said utility and the City of Azusa, covering the sale and purchase of electric energy and service, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company Ltd. be and it is hereby authorized to cancel that special agreement dated October 1, 1941, between said utility and the City of Azusa, covering the sale and purchase of electric energy and service.

The authority herein granted shall become effective as of the date

hereof.
