BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Imperial Highway in the City of Lynwood, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6N-9.05. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs and one existing Standard No. 1 wigwag (G. O. No. 75-B).

Good Cause Appearing,

Pacific Electric Railway Company is exempted from full compliance with Section VI, (d) and (e) of G. O. No. 75-B at this location.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year

unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
