"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Potaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company are authorized to include in their joint track operation in Santa Rosa; Sonoma County, those certain tracks between Engineer's Station 2740+67.7 and Engineer's Station 4+52.8; as shown by dashed red lines on the map (San Rafael Drawing D-3987, revised January 1946); attached to and made a part of First Supplemental Application."

In all other respects Decision No. 38283 shall remain in full force and effect.
