ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company by the above entitled application requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 37296, in Application No. 26057, as amended by Decision No. 37622, in the same application, which authorized it to operate a highway common carrier service between Tulare and Ocotol Field, also known as Rankin Aero Academy.

Ocotol Field was used during the war by the United States Army Air Corps for training purposes. Since the war ended the Air Corps has ceased its use of the field for Army personnel and has abandoned it. There is no need for applicant's service. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 37296, in Application No. 26057, as amended by Decision No. 37622, in Application No. 26057, is revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall, within thirty (30) days from the date hereof and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, issue appropriate

supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
