ORDER OF REVOCATION

By the above entitled supplemental application, J. M. Woodward requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted him by Decision No. 35698, in Application No. 25166, which authorized him to operate a passenger stage service between Yorba Linda, Terminal Island and intermediate points.

The above certificate was granted to enable applicant to provide a needed transportation service for persons employed by the California Shipbuilding Corporation on Terminal Island who resided at or in the vicinity of Yorba Linda, Placentia, Anaheim, Fullerton, Buena Park or Cypress.

Since the war has ended, California Shipbuilding Corporation has discontinued construction of ships. There is no need for applicant's transportation service. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to J. M. Woodward by Decision No. 35698, in Application No. 25166, is hereby revoked and annulled and all

tariffs and time tables filed with the Commission in compliance with such decision are hereby cancelled.
