ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company, by the above entitled supplemental application, requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted it by Decision No. 35346 in Fourth Supplemental Application No. 19598, which authorized it to establish highway common carrier transportation service between South Dos Palos and Eagle Field.

Eagle Field was enlarged and improved by the United States Army Air Corps and used during the war for training of personnel. Applicant alleges that there has been no demand for service at Eagle Field for some time past and that it has been permanently abandoned by the Air Corps. There is no need for applicant's service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 35346 in Fourth Supplemental Application No. 19598 is revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall, within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, issue appropriate supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
