ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company, by the above entitled supplemental application, requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to it by Decision No. 36433 in Application No. 25589, which authorized it to operate a highway common carrier transportation service between Hollister and Hollister Field.

Hollister Field was a Naval Auxiliary Airport used during the war for training and other purposes. The field has been officially closed since October 15, 1945. There is no need for applicant's service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 36433 in Application No. 25589 is revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall, within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, issue appropriate

supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
