ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Motor Trucking Company by the above entitled application requests an order of this Commission revoking the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to it by Decision No. 36019, in Application No. 25380, which authorized it to operate on-call a highway common carrier service between Redding and Redding Airport.

The airport was enlarged and improved by the United States Army Air Corps. It was used to some extent during the war, applicant providing service when it was needed.

Pacific Motor Trucking Company alleges there has been no demand for truck service to or from the Airport for some time past. It appears that the United States Army Air Corps has ceased operating at the Airport and has abandoned it. There is no need for applicant's service. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company by Decision No. 36019, in Application No. 25380 is revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, and on not less than one (1) day's

notice to the Commission and the public, issue appropriate supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
