ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND REVOCATION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 37254 dated August 8, 1944, the Commission issued a certificate to Landier Transit Co. Inc., authorizing passenger stage service between the intersection of 103rd Street and Central Avenue, near the Watts district of Los Angeles, and the intersection of 116th Street and Athens Way in the city of Los Angeles. By its sixth supplemental application filed October 26, 1945, applicant states that the operation authorized by said Decision No. 37254 was never established because of the reasons therein set forth. Such supplemental application requested the Commission to reauthorize such service. On January 24, 1946, applicant filed with the Commission its request for a dismissal of this sixth supplemental application.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the sixth supplemental application No. 24301 filed October 26, 1945, is hereby dismissed and the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 37254 dated August 8, 1944, is hereby revoked and annulled.
