O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track across State Highway at Pacific Avenue (East Fifth Street) in Oxnard, Ventura County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-408.5-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 Flashing Light Signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Applicant shall remove, or cause to be removed, a row of Gum trees east of said crossing and located between State highway and the railroad right of way, for a distance of not less than 500 feet.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public con-

venience, necessity, or safety so require.

This order shall become effective immediately.
