ORDER

The City of Gardena is authorized to construct an alley across the Redondo Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6R-13-60-D, subject to the following condition:

Applicant shall, by suitable ordinance, restrict the flow of traffic to a westerly direction.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance costs between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity or safety so require: This order shall be effective immediately.
