FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By the order in Decision No. 38421, dated November 20, 1945, the Commission, among other things, authorizes Red River Lumber Company to sell and transfer and Pacific Gas and Electric Company to acquire certain electric production, transmission and distribution properties.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company reports that it acquired said properties on December 28, 1945. It has filed a copy of the book entries by which it recorded the properties on its records. We find the entries to be in satisfactory form.

Applicant reports that the instrument of conveyance was executed in duplicate and that the copies were transmitted to the county recorders for the purpose of recordation. Until they are returned to it, applicant is not in a position to file a copy of the deed with the Commission. It therefore requests additional time to file a copy of the deed. We believe that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph 5 of the order in Decision No. 38421, dated November 20, 1945, reading as

: follows:

"5. Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall within sixty (60) days after purchase of said properties file with the Commission a copy of all deeds and instruments under which it acquired and holds title to said properties and rights."

be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"5. Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall, on or before June 30, 1946, file with the Commission a copy of all deeds and instruments under which it acquired and holds title to said properties and rights."
