O P I N I O N

By this supplemental application W. B. McLeran seeks authority to abandon the operation of a passenger stage service for the transportation of school children to and from the Cathedral Chapel School located at 8th and Cochran Streets, and the Blessed Sacrament School located at 6661 Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles, authorized by Decision No. 34580, dated September 11, 1941.

Applicant states that said schools are operating their own busses and that applicant's service has been discontinued by mutual agreement. Representatives of said schools have apprised this Commission that applicant has not been rendering the service for some time, that other arrangements have been consummated which are satisfactory and adequate.

Under the circumstances the application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) That W. B. McLeran is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon operation as a passenger-stage corporation between the Cathedral Chapel School and the Blessed Sacramento School.

(2) That the certificate authorizing such operation, granted by Decision No. 34580 dated September 11, 1941, is hereby revoked and annulled effective concurrently with the cancellation of tariffs as provided for in paragraph (3) of this order, but such revocation and annulment shall become effective not later than 35 days after the effective date of this order.

(3) That applicant shall file supplements to its effective tariffs and time tables in triplicate, within 30 days from the effective date hereof, and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public showing the discontinuance of service as herein authorized.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
