ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 36690 dated November 2, 1943, authorized George Fidler and Cecil Fidler to purchase and acquire from Albert E. Warburton the passenger stage operative right between Martinez and the Permanente Metals Corporation Shipyards at Richmond, granted by Decision No. 36521 in Application No. 25622.

Cecil Fidler, by letter dated February 19, 1946, informs the Commission that such operation was discontinued June 2, 1945, and requests the Commission to revoke the operative right.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights created by Decisions Nos. 36521 and 36690 are hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of George Fidler and Cecil Fidler are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof.
