In the Matter of the Application of GUY S. ALEXANDER and L. B. LARSON, a copartnership, known as the BISHOP-MONO LAKE STAGE LINE, to sell and M. C. YAHNE, INC., dba INLAND STAGES, and WESTERN TRUCK LINES, LTD., to purchase an automotive passenger, baggage, and express line operative right between Bishop and Mono Lake, California, and certain intermediate points on the main highway and stated points located off said main highway.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

Decision No. 38620, dated January 22, 1946, authorized M. C. Yahne, Inc., to acquire from Guy S. Alexander and L. B. Larson an operative right for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Bishop and Mono Lake and certain intermediate and off-route points. The order of the decision referred to required the filing of tariffs and time tables within 60 days from the effective date thereof.

Yahne Inc. has requested the Commission to consolidate the right referred to with its passenger stage operative rights between Los Angeles and the California-Nevada State line north of Coleville via Bishop and Mono Lake. It has also requested an extension of time within which to file tariffs and time tables required as above stated.

It is stated that by such consolidation, applicant herein would be able to provide a more efficient and adequate service between Bishop and Mono Lake and intermediate points, on its equipment operating between Los Angeles and Reno.

As such request appears to be in the public interest, it will be granted without public hearing.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the operative right herein referred to is hereby consolidated with and made a part of the operative right created by Decision No. 26568, dated November 25, 1933, in Application No. 19173

(2) That the time within which applicants Guy S. Alexander and L. B. Larson and M. C. Yahne, Inc., shall file tariffs and time tables as required by Decision No. 38620 is hereby extended to and including May 1, 1946. Such filings may be made upon not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
