SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant transports fuel oil in bulk in tank trucks for Tide Water Associated Oil Company within and in the vicinity of San Jose. For reasons set forth in Decision No. 32928 of March 26, .1940, as amended, in this proceeding, he has been authorized to observe a rate: lower than the minimum rate otherwise applicable to this transportation. The authority will-expire March 26, 1946. By verified supplemental application applicant seeks extension of this authority for such period as the Commission may deem appropriate.

. It is represented that no consequential changes in operating costs have been experienced since this matter was last considered a year ago, that general conditions surrounding the transportation involved are substantially the same as those them prevailing, and that the authorized rate still produces adequate revenues.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that a one-year extension of applicant's authority is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 32928 of March 26, 1940, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to March 26, 1947, unless sooner changed or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective upon the date hereof.
