In the Matter of the Application of the CITY OF SEAL BEACH, Orange County, California, for authority to construct hard surfaced sidewalks. ) Application No. 27288

ORDER

The City of Seal Beach is authorized to construct two sidewalk crossings at grade across the Newport Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company at Main Street at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6E-24.06. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense; also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of sidewalks shall be as set forth in the application with grades of approach conforming to the existing street grade. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by existing protective devices.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
