The existing zones are coextensive with the corporate limits of Clovis. It is alleged in the verified petition that the proposed extension involves an area which is contiguous to and actually a part of the community, and that petitioners desire to accord industries and persons within that area the same service and rates as those now available within the existing zones. tional territory is within three miles of the corporate limits. Competing cerriers have been notified of the filing of the petition and have offered no objection to its being granted.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the petition should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of Southern Pacific Company and Pacific Motor Trucking Company, seeking authority to I ATTHE LOOK enlarge their pickup and delivery zones at Clovis, Fresno County, be Student of Name Wage A Commence
