O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company are authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across 7th and 10th Streets in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application. Said streets are not open or traveled at the points of crossing and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of the streets across said track. Applicants shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
