ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pacific Greyhound Lines, by the above entitled supple-
mental application, requests an order of this Commission revoking
the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to
it by Decision No. 37990 in Application No. 26751, as amended by
Decision No. 38194 in the same application, which authorized it
to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Tiburon and
California Point Junction serving the Navy Ammunition Dump at the
latter point.

Applicant was granted the certificate above mentioned
primarily to enable it to render service to the Navy Ammunition
Dump. After the termination of the war, the Federal Government
abandoned plans for the construction and maintenance of the Navy
Ammunition Dump. There is no need for applicant's service,

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience
and necessity heretofore granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines by
Decisions Nos. 37990 and 38194 in Application No. 26751, are

revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall, within 30 days from the date hereof and on not less than 1 day's notice to the Commission and the public, issue appropriate supplements of cancellation to its tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
