FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph (6) appearing on pages 8 and 9 of the order contained in Decision No. 38789, in Application No. 26748, dated March 26, 1946, in the proceedings referred to above reading as follows:

"(6) That pursuant to Application No. 26748, as amended, a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted Gibson Lines authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined by Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and shipments of express weighing not in excess of 100 pounds each on passenger carrying vehicles only, between Roseville and a point where U.S. Highway No. 40 crosses the California-Nevada state line near Floriston, California."

be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(6) That pursuant to Application No. 26748, as amended, a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted Gibson Lines authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined by Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and shipments of express weighing not in excess of 100 pounds each on passenger carrying vehicles only, between Roseville and a point where U.S. Highway No. 40 crosses the California-Nevada state line near Floriston, California, subject to the restriction that local intrastate traffic in California east of Roseville shall be maintained on through interstate buses provided, however, that in the event of a breakdown of any such through interstate bus another bus may be substituted."

In all other respects, Decision No. 38789 shall remain in full force and effect.
