## OPINION

Pacific Electric Railway Company, by the above entitled application as amended, requests that the Commission issue it a certificate of public convenience and necessity embodying therein the complete passenger stage operative rights granted to it by some 28 decisions now in effect.

All of applicants present passenger stage operations are included in this request for a consolidated certificate except those operated jointly with the Los Angeles Transit Lines under the designation of "Los Angeles Motor Coach Lines". Pacific Electric Railway Company does not seek to make any change in equipment operated, schedules of service, tariffs, rules or regulations applicable to its motor coach lines. Applicant is authorized to transport express not exceeding 100 pounds per shipment and baggage, as well as passengers, on some of the routes it opcrates. Under present authority, Pacific Electric Railway Company may operate its passenger stage service as a merged, unified and consolidated system. It desires to retain this right.

Applicant has been authorized to suspend service of three of the operative rights involved in this proceeding. Suspension for the duration of the war emergency was authorized on a line in the city of Los Angeles from an off-street terminal at

California and Hill Streets, via Hill Street and Olympic Boulevard to Olive Street. Applicant has been authorized to suspend operation of a line between Los Angeles, Glendale and Burbank until November 23, 1946. A suspension without time limit was authorized on the line commencing at the Hollywood Union Travel Depot located at 1625 Cahuenga Boulevard in Los Angeles via Wilcox Avenue, Selma Avenue, Highland Avenue and Cahuenga Boulevard to the intersection of Lankershim and Ventura Boulevards. Applicant asks that the above suspensions be continued.

This does not appear to be a matter which requires public hearing. The objective is to incorporate in one decision the passenger stage operative rights of Pacific Electric Railway Company, and to cancel the numerous decisions outstanding on April 1, 1946, which created such rights. After full consideration of the evidence of record the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require that this application be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity, not in addition to nor as an enlargement of its existing rights but commensurate therewith, authorizing it to operate as a passenger stage corporation within and between Los Angeles, Ocean Park, Santa Monica, Castellammare, Tarzana, Canoga Park, San Fernando, Sunland, Pasadena, El Monte, Baldwin Park, Covina, San Dimas, La Verne, Claremont, San Bernardino, Redlands, Colton, Corona, Orange, Santa Ana, Riverside, Ontario, Pomona, Seal Beach, Balboa, Long Beach, Huntington Park, Palos Verdes Estates, El Segundo, Playa del Rey, Garden Grove, Brea, Whittier and intermediste points.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant is authorized to turn its motor vehicles at termini, or at points en route where it is necessary to serve a loading point, either in the intersection of streets, or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, provided that municipal traffic regulations are observed and complied with.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant is authorized to divert from its established routes, either on its regular schedules or on special schedules, for the purpose of transporting bona fide pupils attending an institution of learning, between their homes and such institution of learning, provided that such divergence and schedules therefor are filed in the same manner as other time schedules and, if special rates are provided, schedules thereof are also filed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company by this decision is subject to the restrictions set forth below. Such restrictions apply to specific routes now used by Pacific Electric Railway Company and will be identified by the numbers which appear in Appendix A attached hereto, and by this reference made a part thereof, which describes such routes.

- 1. Pacific Electric Railway Company may transport passengers, baggage and express, the latter not to exceed 100 pounds per shipment, on routes 1-A, 1-B, 1-C, 2-A, 2-B, 2-C, 2-D, 2-E, 3-A, 3-B, 3-C, 4-A, 4-E, 4-C, 4-D, 5-A, 5-B, 5-C, 6-A, 5-B, 6-C, and 6-D.
- 2. Applicant may transport express matter in the custody of Railway Express Agency, Incorporated, for shipment over the lines of Southern Pacific Company as well as passengers and their baggage destined to, or coming from, through trains of Southern Pacific Company at Colton on rootes 2-C and 2-D.

- 3. Applicant shall not transport passengers, baggage or express in the city of Los Angeles between any two points located on Marengo Street between Mission Road and Soto Street; nor between Main Street Station at 6th and Main Streets and the intersection of Brooklyn and Rowan Streets on route 3-C.
- 4. Applicant shall not transport passengers, baggage or express in the city of Los Angeles between any two points both of which are south or east of the intersection of San Fernando and Verdugo Roads on route 6-A.
- 5. Pacific Electric Railway Company may transport only passengers on routes 20-1, 20-1, 21-1, 21-1, 21-2, 22-1, 22-1, 22-2, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34-1, 34-1, 34-1, 34-1, 35-1, 35-1, 35-1, 36-1,
- 6. Applicant shall not transport any passengers on route 20-A in the city of Los Angeles whose origin and destination are between its subway terminal on Hill Street and the intersection of La Brea and Slauson Avenues.
- 7. Applicant shall not transport passengers on route 21-A in the city of Los Angeles whose origin and destination are between its loading deck on Olive Street and the intersection of Fairfax Avenue and Olympic Boulevard.
- 8. Applicant shall transport passengers between points located along that portion of route 21-B between the intersection of Pier Avenue and Main Street, and the intersection of Santa Monica and Westwood Boulevards on through interurban schedules only.
- 9. Applicant shall not transport on route 22-A any passengers whose origin and destination are between its loading deck at Olive and Fifth Streets in the city of Los Angèles and any point east of La Cienega Boulevard in the city of Beverly Hills.
- 10. Applicant shall not transport passengers on routes 1-A or 34-A in the city of Los Angeles whose origin and destination are between its Main Street station at 6th and Main Streets and Indiana Street.
- 11. Applicant shall not transport passengers on route 34-C in the city of Long Beach whose origin and destination are between points intermediate to the intersection of Hathaway and Kimeno Avenues and the intersection of Second Street and the San Gabriel River.
- 12. The authority granted to applicant to operate over and along route 38 shall expire 180 days after the termination of the present war shall have been officially proclaimed, or at such earlier time as the Commission by further order may designate.

IT IS FURTHER OFDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to suspend, for the duration of the war emergency, its passenger stage service over and along route 50.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to suspend its passenger stage service over and along route 51 until November 23, 1946.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway
Company is authorized to suspend its pessenger stage service over
and along route 52.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in conducting passenger stage operations pursuant to the certificate granted by this decision, Pacific Electric Railway Company shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed 30 days from the effective date hereof.
- (b) Applicant shall conduct such presenger stage service over and along the routes described in Arpendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be 30 days from the date hereof.
