O R D E R

THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Scotts Avenue in Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application. Scotts Avenue is not open at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing its opening to public use and travel across said track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
