DECISION NO. 38844

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment of its Class "E" non-agency station of Park Street, County of Santa Cruz, State of California, and to cancel all freight rate tariffs to and from said station.

ORDER

The verified application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Park Street for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Park Street, County of Santa Cruz; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein; applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year; unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
