OPINION AND ORDER.

Carbona Growers Corporation requests authority to sell to A. T. Fugitt and J. B. Minatta public utility warehouse property located at Rhodes, San Joaquin County, for a cash consideration of \$20,000. The purchasers are experienced warehousemen. They propose no change in the service to the public or in the rates therefor. Public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Carbona Growers Corporation be and it is hereby authorized to sell the public utility warehouse property involved in this application to A. T. Fugitt and J. B. Minatta, in accordance with the terms of the agreement incorporated therein; and that A. T. Fugitt and J. B. Minatta shall, concurrently with the commencement of warehouse operations at Rhodes, file rates, rules and regulations identical with those now maintained by Carbona Growers Corporation, in conformity with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the

Commission's General Order No. 61 and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
