OPINION AND ORDER

Terra Bella Warehouse Company, a corporation, proposes to sell its public utility warehouse property situated at Terra Bella, Tulare County, to Francis J. Muller. The consideration involved is \$5,000, payable in cash. Muller, an experienced warehouseman, owns and operates public storage facilities located at Ducor, a nearby community. At Terra Bella, he proposes to provide service similar to that now provided by the corporation. The existing rates will not be changed. Public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Terra Bella Warehouse Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to sell the public utility warehouse property involved in this application to Francis J. Muller, in accordance with the terms of the agreement attached thereto; and that Francis J. Muller shall, concurrently with the commencement of warehouse operations at Terra Bella, file rates, rules and regulations identical with those now maintained by Terra Bella Warehouse Company, in conformity with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in

the Commission's General Order No. 61 and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
