In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad side track across Locust Street, in the City of Gridley, County of Butte, State of California

Application No. 27379

O R D E R

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to relocate two side tracks at grade across Locust Street in Gridley, Butte County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. C-157.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) now in place.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
