O R D E R

The County of Riverside is authorized to construct a public crossing at grade across Southern Pacific Company near Caleb, Riverside County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-630.0. Southern Pacific Company shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost between lines two feet outside of rails. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty feet and grades of approach not greater than eight per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-629.2, about forty-two hundred (4,200) feet west, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
