## ORDER

The County of Santa Cruz is authorized to reconstruct and المورمون ووالعجاز المعامية براء widen the crossing at grade of Graham Hill Road with the branch line and the street of the contract track of Southern Pacific Company near Felton, identified as Cross-ing No. EC-127.5. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails, Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on Exhibit "B" attached to the application. Contracting the second of the second Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. Carlina Landon No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
